NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF PUTATIVE CLASS ACTION, REQUEST FOR INFORMATION, AND

TO: PERSONS WHO WERE EMPLOYED ON AN HOURLY BASIS, AT ANY TIME FROM DECEMBER 1, 2002 TO THE PRESENT, BY PJ GROUP, INC. OR WEST COAST DISTRIBUTION, INC.

PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY. YOUR RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED BY LITIGATION NOW PENDING IN THE ABOVE-ENTITLED COURT.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that there is now pending in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles, an action (“the Litigation”) on behalf of all persons who were employed on an hourly basis by PJ Group, Inc. and/or West Coast Distribution, Inc. at any time between December 1, 2002 and the present;

The Plaintiffs in the Litigation allege that PJ Group, Inc., West Coast Distribution, Inc. and Seven for All Mankind, LLC violated provisions of California Labor and Wage and Hour law by failing to provide their employees with all required meal breaks and rest breaks, and by failing to properly compensate their employees for overtime hours. PJ Group, Inc., West Coast Distribution, Inc. and Seven for All Mankind dispute the allegations.

The Court has Ordered employees who are (or were) employed by PJ Group, Inc. and/or West Coast Distribution, Inc. at any time from December 1, 2002 to the present (“Relevant Period”), to be provided a notice to advise you that Plaintiffs are seeking to obtain your name, address, and telephone number. Accordingly, PJ Group, Inc. and West Coast Distribution, Inc. have compiled a list of employees employed during the Relevant Period and are sending this notice to see if you object to the release of this information. If you are receiving this notice, you may be a member of the putative class of plaintiffs.

The attorneys for the Plaintiffs in the Litigation are conducting an investigation regarding meal breaks and rest breaks, and overtime. In order to assist in the investigation, the attorneys for the Plaintiffs wish to gather information regarding the nature of the work you do (or used to do) while employed by PJ Group, Inc. and/or West

Coast Distribution, Inc., including the meal breaks and rest breaks you received or did not receive, and the amount of overtime you worked and the compensation you received for overtime. They have sought to obtain the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of PJ Group, Inc. and West Coast Distribution, Inc. employees so that they can communicate with them about the allegations made in the Litigation.

This notice is being sent to you to determine if you object to Plaintiffs' counsel receiving your name, address, and telephone number. **You are not required to release the information to Plaintiffs' attorneys and you have the right to elect not to provide your name, address, and telephone number to Plaintiffs' attorneys.** Plaintiffs' attorneys would like to have your names, addresses and telephone numbers to help in the investigation and determine whether the Plaintiffs' allegations in the Litigation are accurate.

Therefore, if you **AGREE** to Plaintiffs' attorneys receiving your name, address and telephone number to aid in their investigation, **you do not need to do anything** in response to this notice. You may also return the enclosed postcard after checking the option that reads:

“YES. I agree to have my name, address and telephone number disclosed to the attorneys.”

However, if you **DO NOT AGREE** to your name, address, or telephone number being provided to the Plaintiffs' attorneys, you must return the enclosed self addressed postcard with postage prepaid, advising the Court and the parties that you do not authorize the release of your name, address and telephone number to Plaintiffs' counsel. **If you do not agree to the disclosure of your name address and telephone number, you must check the postcard option that reads:**

“NO. I do not want my name, address and telephone number disclosed to the attorneys.”

The postcard must be received no later than 15 days following the date of mailing of this notice or your name, address and telephone number will be released to Plaintiffs' counsel.
